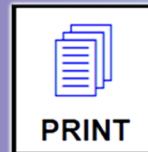

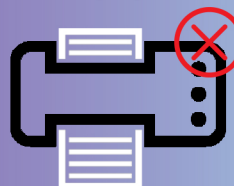

Before printing, select "actual size"

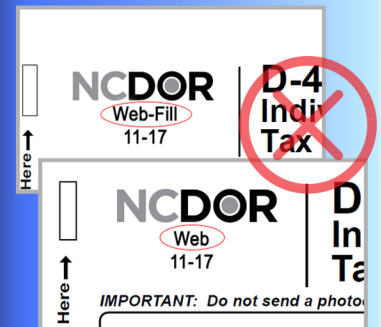


Do not select "print both sides of the paper"

A part-year resident or a nonresident who receives income from N.C. sources must complete this form to determine the percentage of total income from all sources that is subject to N.C. tax. You are a **"part-year resident"** if you moved to N.C. and became a resident during the tax year, or you moved out of N.C. and became a resident of another state during the tax year. You are a **"nonresident"** if you were not a resident of N.C. at any time during the tax year.
