Guidelines

Do not handwrite any information



Do not use commas when entering amounts

Enter Whole U.S. Dollars Only [X] 1. 99,999.00

Enter Whole U.S. Dollars Only [check] 1. 99999.00

Do not use brackets for negative numbers

Use a minus sign to show the amount is negative

Enter Whole U.S. Dollars Only [X] 1. [99999.00]

Enter Whole U.S. Dollars Only [check] 1. -99999.00

Printing

Use the print icon on the form to ensure you have completed all required fields



Before printing, select "actual size"

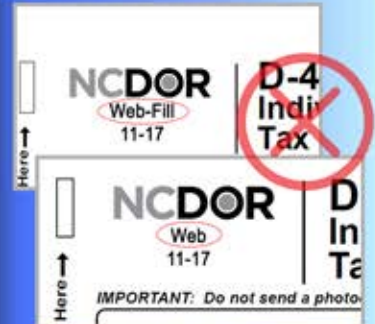


Do not print on both sides of the paper

D-407V Estates and Trusts Payment Voucher

Generally, the fiduciary responsible for administering an estate or trust must file an income tax return and pay the tax due for the estate or trust for which he acts if he is required to file a federal return for estates and trusts and (1) the estate or trust derives income from North Carolina sources or (2) the estate or trust derives any income which is for the benefit of a resident of North Carolina.

The Department offers an eFile service that allows Estates and Trusts to file and pay North Carolina tax online. If you choose to file electronically, visit <https://www.ncdor.gov/file-pay/efile-businesses/efile-resources-estates-and-trusts> to access a list of approved eFile providers and products. Benefits of filing and paying taxes using eFile software, include:

- Ability to file and pay State and federal at the same time
- Accurate, secure, convenient
- Schedule payments in advance
- Pay by bank draft with no convenience fee
- Confirmation that your return and payment have been received

Important: If you eFile your Estates and Trusts return and elect not to pay electronically, complete the voucher below. Staple your payment to the top left corner of the voucher. Send the voucher and payment to the address listed below.

If you elect to file your Estates and Trusts return by mail, staple your payment to your return (do not use this voucher) and mail your return and payment to the address listed below.
