1. *Scrap tire disposal taxes are levied pursuant to G.S. 105-187.16 and 105-187.19 which provide for a per capita distribution of the proceeds on a quarterly basis.*
2. *This report reflects collections for the months of January 2011 through March 2011 on sales of tires during the months of December 2010 through February 2011.*
3. *Per S.L. 2010-31 Section 2.2(d) and S.L. 2010-123 Section 1.2(a), the Scrap Tire Disposal Account, which is 17% of the Scrap Tire Disposal Tax Distribution, will be credited to the General Fund for distributions made by the Secretary during the 2010-2011 fiscal year.*
