- 3. Per S.L. 2010-31 Section 2.2(d) and S.L. 2010-123 Section 1.2(a) the Scrap Tire Disposal Account which is 17% of the Scrap Tire Disposal Tax Distribution will be credited to the General Fund for distributions made by the Secretary during the 2010-2011 fiscal year.*
