3. *For taxes levied during the 2011-2012 fiscal year, Session Law 2011-145, Section 2.2.(f), requires the Secretary to credit the sum of \$2,268,989 from the Scrap Tire Disposal Account, which is 17% of the net tax proceeds from the Scrap Tire Disposal Tax Distribution, to the General Fund .*
