2. *This report reflects collections for the months of April 2022 through June 2022.*
3. *Payments of the white goods disposal tax proceeds were withheld from those local governments that, per notification from the Secretary of the Department of Environmental Quality, failed to comply with the requirements of G.S. 130A-309.09A(b), 130A-309.09A(d), and G.S. 130A-309.09(B)a, as amended by S.L. 2013-360 and S.L. 2013-409, and with G.S. 130A-309.87. The withheld white goods disposal tax proceeds will remain in the General Fund.*
